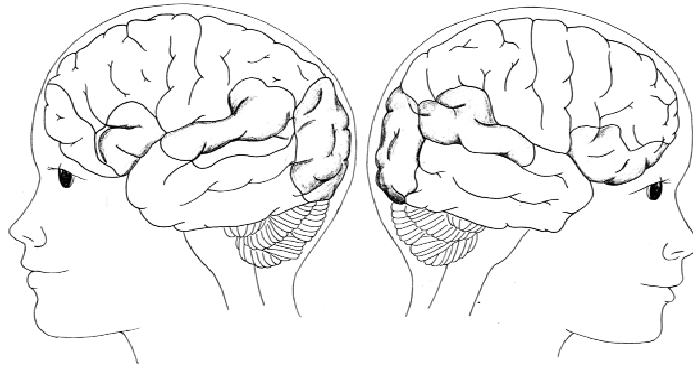


DEAN'S FACULTY FORUM
