- No major course may be taken Pass/Fail
- Students may double-count up to three courses between the Environmental Studies major. Check the Bulletin for rules on double-counting courses.
- Students may double-count up to two courses between the Environmental Studies major and a minor.
- Students may use up to two non-Tufts classes toward the Environmental Studies major. This does not apply to classes taken in Tufts abroad programs.
- Students may only use one ex-college class toward the Environmental Studies major.
