- 15 courses required: 5 cores, 5 skill-based, 4 track-specific, 1 capstone, 1 internship (ENV 99).
- All course substitutions must be formally petitioned and approved by the Environmental Studies Program.
- No major course may be taken Pass/Fail.
- Students may double-count up to five courses between the Applied Environmental Studies major and a second major. Check the Bulletin for rules on double-counting courses.
- Students may double-count up to two courses between the Applied Environmental Studies major and a minor.
- Students may use up to (approved) four non-Tufts classes toward the Applied Environmental Studies major. This does not apply to classes taken in Tufts abroad programs.
- Students may only use one (approved) Ex-college class toward the Environmental Studies major.
